# PROJECT INFORMATION Midterm: Interview Role Play

# **Speaking (20 points)**

#### • Format and Structure

o Role play follows interview format

#### • **Time**: 6-8 minutes

o 15 seconds more or less lose ½ point, 30 seconds more or less loses 1 point

# Well prepared

- o All members are on time and ready to present with all necessary materials
- o Teacher can see that the group has practiced
- Not reading a script

#### • Introduction

- o Interviewer signals the start of the interview
- o Both interviewer and interviewee should give some kind of greeting/introduction

# • Expressions and Attitude

- o Eye contact
- o Appropriate and expressive gestures and facial expressions
- o Confident and positive body language (matches the character)

#### Interaction

- o Interviewee listens and responds to the interviewer
- o Interviewer directs questions to interviewee and listens politely to responses

## Speaking

- Volume (loud and clear)
- o Clear pronunciation
- o Good pace (talking speed)
- o Proper grammar and vocabulary
- o Fluency (few pauses or "ummm's")

## Appropriate Questions

- O the questions help the interviewee describe his/her skills or personality and tell why he/she is best for the job? Do the questions match the situation and help to move the story forward?
- o Follow up Questions (interviewer must ask at least 3 follow up questions)
- o Interviewee must ask at least one question to the interviewer

## • Appropriate Answers and Use of class material

- o Complete answers with details, descriptions and examples
- Use strengths and weaknesses from our personality tests/discussions
- o Discuss skills, experience and other information

## Closing

- o Employer signals end of interview
- o Both employer and applicant should give some sort of "thank you"

## Surprise Questions!

 I will have a list of random questions. Each group must choose 2 of these questions before they begin and use them in their role play. They will be general interview questions. Some will be silly or strange.

# **Participation** (5 points)

- These points will be given individually and may be different for each member in the same team.
- Each team member must complete a self assessment of their participation in the group during the preparation and presentation of this project.
- Each team member must also give a score to another team member. You should give an honest score for your other team members. If they had good participation give them a high score. If they were not a good team member, give them a low score.
- I will then compare the scores and use my own observations to determine a final participation score for each team member.

## **Tips and Reminders**

# • Be entertaining

- O You are an actor, this should be fun to watch!
- o Use language and active gestures and body language that are appropriate
- o Interact with each other in a normal way
- o I may give extra points if your role play is really fun to watch

#### • Do not read a script

- o Practice with your group many times so that you can speak easily and comfortably
- Try not to memorize lines. Your role play might be a little different each time you practice it or present it. This is speaking practice. Not memorization practice. Don't worry about remembering what will you say. Just have an idea.

#### • Use material from the class

- o Personality tests and discussions (strengths, weaknesses, skills)
- o Resume (objective, education, experience, skills, awards, etc.)
- o Practice Interviews (Group Resume, Speed Interviewing)

#### Be creative

- You could choose a funny or silly job or situation. You might also choose to show a really bad applicant with a terrible resume
- o I may give extra points for creativity
